Most Inspiring Individual: Senior

Senior category: for nominees aged 18 years and over.

This award aims to acknowledge individuals who have made outstanding contributions to the local community and who are see as inspirational role models.

Nominees could be making a positive difference to the community through a variety of ways; i.e. going above and beyond in their call of duty, having a recognised commitment to the community, being involved or supportive of local project initiatives etc.

Most Inspiring Individual: Junior

Junior category: for nominees under 18 years of age.

This category recognises young local residents who are making a positive impact in the community and are inspiring his/her peers through their actions.

Nominees could be making a positive difference in the community through their personal attitude, involvement in the local community through after school activities, etc.

Senior Sports Hero

Senior category: for nominees aged 18 years and over.

This category recognises individuals who have made/ are making a positive impact in the sporting life of the local community — either in a playing or supporting capacity.

Nominees could be active members of a local club; taking part in a particular sport and/or assisting and supporting local sport behind the scenes. Nominees may be aspiring athletes, are recognised for their dedication to sport in general, ambassadors for local sport etc.

Junior Sports Hero

For young residents under 18 years of age.

This category recognises locals who are making a positive impact in the sporting life of the local community – either in a playing or supporting capacity.

Young sports heroes can be those who involve themselves in the local sports on offer (both school based and community based), encourage fellow peers to become involved in local sports, are recognised for their dedication to sport in general etc.

Volunteer of the Year:

Do you know someone who volunteers much of their spare time to the local community? Perhaps they dedicate their time and efforts to a local organisation, or even a number of local clubs? This category recognises the voluntary work in the local community and is open to those who dedicate time and support to a local club/group or to the community as a whole.

Green Thumb of the Year:

This category recognises someone who is making a continuous and impressive effort in the beautification of their personal areas and to the area of Mount Morgan. Nominees could be those who strive to see their and/or other properties well kept and those who make an inspiring effort in the garden.

Nominees could also be those who inspire others through tidying public areas, instigatating community clean ups etc.

Arts Ambassador of the Year:

This category is open to individuals, community groups and small cottage industries.

This category recognises those who are making an inspiring effort in the field of arts and/or literature – this could be through artwork, creative writing, photography, involvement in performing arts, music etc.

Nominees could be bringing positive promotion to the local area through their endeavours and/or striving to enhance creativity in the community.

Employee of the Year

This category recognises a local employee who goes above and beyond in their workplace.

Nominees may be those who frequently demonstrate a high level of customer care and provide outstanding service.

Nominations can be made by nominee's employer, a friend, member of the community etc.
